It's a picnic! From 1:00 to 2:00, picnic and bid on silent auction items. Enjoy music along the riverbank. A raffle to win a kayak will be held at 2:00pm!

It's a paddle! At 2:15pm

Canoe the Pigeon River from the Trading Post to the Nasby Dam. Led by Pokagon State Park Interpretive Naturalist, Fred Wooley. It's an easy 1 ½ hour float. Paddlers will be picked up and transported back to the Trading Post.

Cost for canoe trip: \$30.00 per adult paddler (14 and up), \$15 for youth paddler (11-13, one per canoe), \$6 for middle riders (10 and under, limit two per canoe). Maximum riders in canoe: two paddlers, two middle riders. Tickets may be purchased at the Turning Point Homeless Shelter in Angola, Indiana. For further information, call the shelter at 665-9191. Ticket price includes a box picnic lunch, canoe rental with shuttle service, and one free raffle ticket (additional raffle tickets for sale at the event!).
